**Exam prep**

- At the time of scheduling your appointment, you will be advised how to prepare for the exam.
- Some pelvic ultrasound examinations require a full bladder. You may be instructed to drink several glasses of water 90 minutes before our appointment.
- Some abdomen ultrasound examinations require you to be fasting, nothing to eat or drink at midnight until your procedure is completed.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment time to check-in.

**Exam Duration**

- Most Ultrasound patients should plan to spend 30- 60 minutes at our facility. The length of the appointment will depend upon the exam your healthcare provider ordered.
- The technologist will help you onto the table, and once you're comfortable the exam will begin.

**Results**

- Once the exam is completed, a certified Radiologist will review the study and dictate the final report.
- This report will be sent to the healthcare provider who ordered your exam.
- Results are available through the LRGHealthcare patient portal. You may enroll in the patient portal at the time of check-in. Please ask the receptionist for details.
- We recommend you follow up with your healthcare provider to discuss the final results of your examination.
